Sustainable Development and Industrial Policies: Emerging Issues for Europe and South Asia

Mr. Cristiano Pasini

UNIDO Representative in India and
Director of the Sub Regional Office for Southern Asia

Mr. Cristiano Massimo Pasini, was appointed UNIDO Representative in India and Director of the Sub Regional Office for Southern Asia covering Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Maldives, Nepal and Sri Lanka as of July 2024. He brings over 20 years of high-level professional experience to his role at UNIDO. His diverse career includes various senior managerial positions related to sustainable industrial development, poverty reduction and post-conflict recovery at national, regional and global level. Before his assignment for India, he served as the Director of the Division for Industrial Policy Advice and Statistics in Vienna, where he led the team responsible for providing Industrial Policy assistance to UNIDO's Member States and the flagship publications such as The Industrial Development Report and Statistical Yearbook. Mr. Pasini also held the position of Director of the Regional Office of UNIDO for Mexico and Central America and UNIDO Representative for Colombia, Peru, Guyana and Suriname and UNIDO Representative for Lebanon and Syria (2013-2019), leading strategic and programmatic engagements for the organization in those regions and countries. Between 2011 and 2013, Mr. Pasini served as the UNIDO Country Coordinator for Iraq, overseeing a special program to support the country's industrial rehabilitation. Mr. Pasini holds a Doctorate Degree in Mechanical Engineering from Sapienza University in Rome, as well as a Master of Business Administration (MBA) from the SDA Bocconi School of Management. He is married and has two children.

EU-India Relations: Quo Vadis? Charting the Path Forward

SPEAKER

H.E. Mr. Hervé Delphin
Honourable Ambassador of the
European Union to India and Bhutan



Hervé Delphin assumed duties as Ambassador of the European Union to India and Bhutan on 18 September 2023. With a career spanning 30 years with the European Union (EU), he is a specialist in foreign policy and international relations. Prior to his posting in India, he was heading the policy planning at the European Diplomatic Service, EEAS, where he also served as Acting Director of Strategic Communications and Foresight. From 2014 to 2017, he was Head of the Unit in the European Commission in charge of the EU humanitarian and emergency response to major crises in the European Neighbourhood and the Middle East. Previously, he served as the Head of the Cabinet of European Commissioner for International Cooperation, Humanitarian Aid and Crisis Response, Kristalina Georgieva and as Deputy Head of the Cabinet of Commissioners Louis Michel and Karel de Gucht, responsible for the development policy and external relations with African, Caribbean and Pacific countries. He is a visiting professor at the College of Europe, Department of International Relations and Diplomatic Studies, in Bruges (Belgium). He has published several papers and articles related to international relations and global strategic issues. A French national, he was awarded the title of "Knight of the Legion of Honour" (Légion d'Honneur), the highest French National Order, in 2014. Hervé Delphin holds a double Master's degree in Political Sciences and Contemporary History from the Institut d'Etudes Politiques and a Master's degree in European Studies from the College of Europe in Bruges. He is married and father of five children.

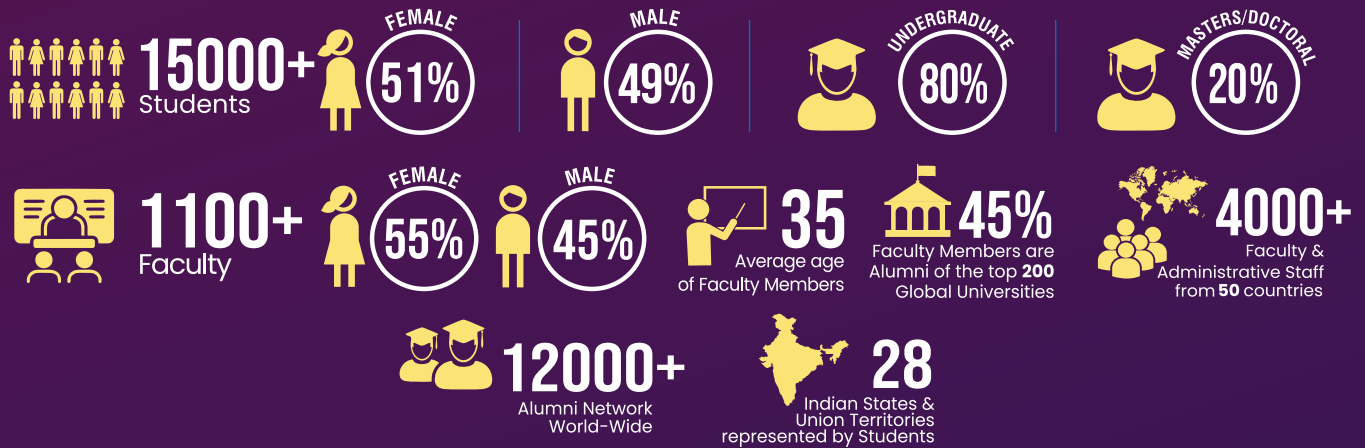
