STRUCTURING FOREIGN INVESTMENTS IN THE BACKDROP OF INTERNATIONAL INVESTMENT AGREEMENTS

The lecture will look at the protections to an investor under Bilateral Investment Treaty (BIT)/Investment Agreements and then concentrate on the characteristics which an investment should have to bring it within the scope of the BIT.
