This two-day workshop aims to equip faculty with the revision processes of rewriting and restructuring to help turn a Ph.D. thesis into a book manuscript. The workshop will also cover the workings of the anonymous review process for academic book manuscripts. Participants will also receive feedback on their manuscript-in-progress.
