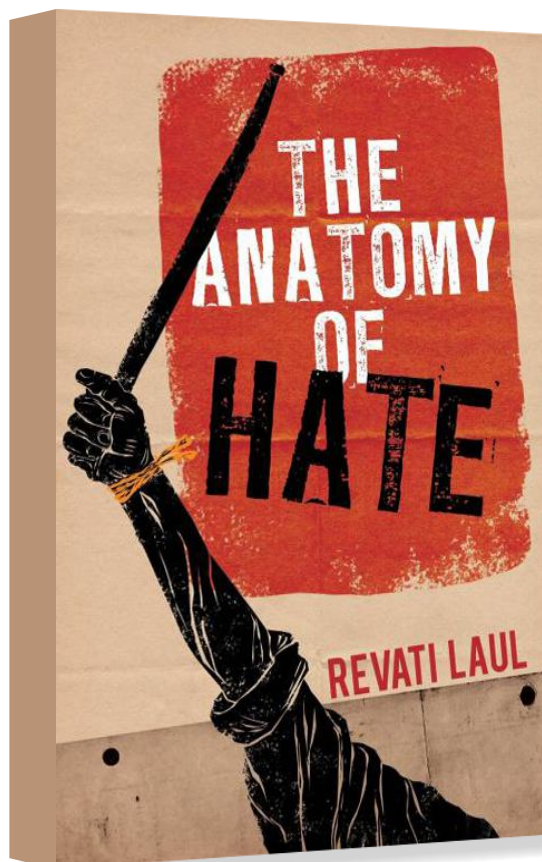

Revati Laul discusses her recently released book that tries to understand the nature and basis of hate violence by following the lives of those who perpetrated it in the 2002 Gujarat Pogrom.
