Consultant, Regional Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) for Assam and North-Eastern states, UNICEF India

Mr. Nishant Buragohain is currently working with UNICEF India as the Regional Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) Consultant for Assam and North-Eastern states. Prior to work with UNICEF-India he was the Emergency Programme Manager (Nepal) for Christian Aid (CAID). Among his various duties with CAID in Nepal he was managing CAID's Start Fund Nepal Flood Response 2017, ensuring effective implementation and monitoring of CAID supported earthquake response programme activities (Livelihood, WASH, Shelter, Education and DRR), managing the programme in compliance with

humanitarian standards and in line with CAID's financial policies and procedures, ensuring timely and quality reporting to donors and coordination with various government agencies. Prior to his work in Nepal Mr. Nishant Buragohain was Humanitarian Programme Coordinator for Oxfam-India in the ECHO [European Civil Protection and Humanitarian Aid Operations] Post-Conflict Recovery project in Assam (2015-2016). He has also served as the Humanitarian Desk Officer (Nepal) for Registered Engineers for Disaster Relief India [RedR-India], Project Coordinator for the Mercy Corps supported and ECHO Funded Post-Conflict Recovery Project in Bodoland Territorial Region, Assam (2014-2015), Project Manager Mercy Corps supported Flood Recovery Project post-Phailin project in Odisha (2014), Mercy Corps supported Flood Recovery Project in Uttarakhand (2014), Training and Projects Officer, RedR-India (2011-2013). Nishant has a postgraduate degree in Disaster Management from the Tata Institute of Social Sciences (Mumbai) and has an undergraduate honors degree in Political Science from Delhi University.
