- Proficiency in English (spoken and written) is required.



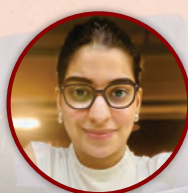

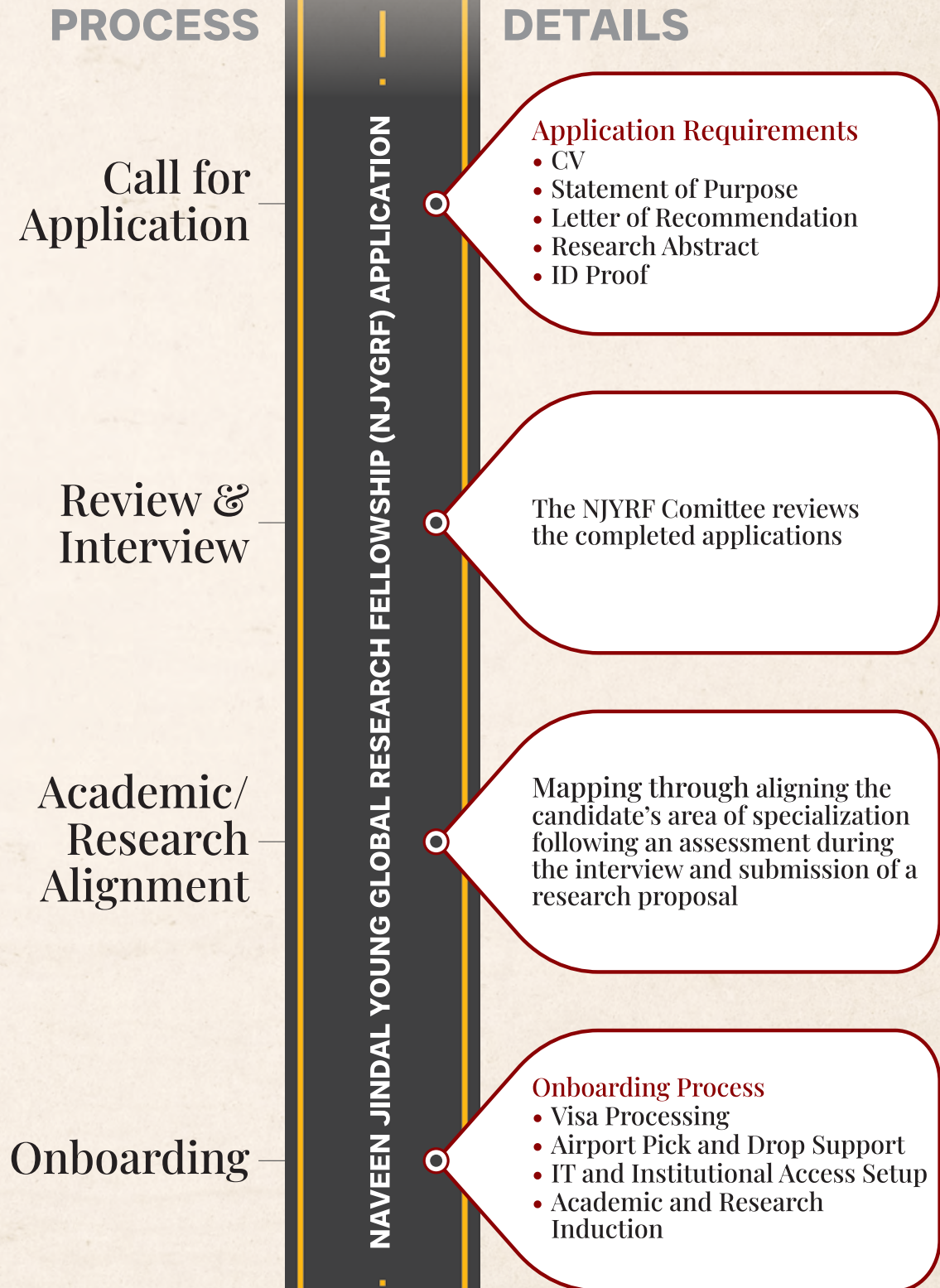

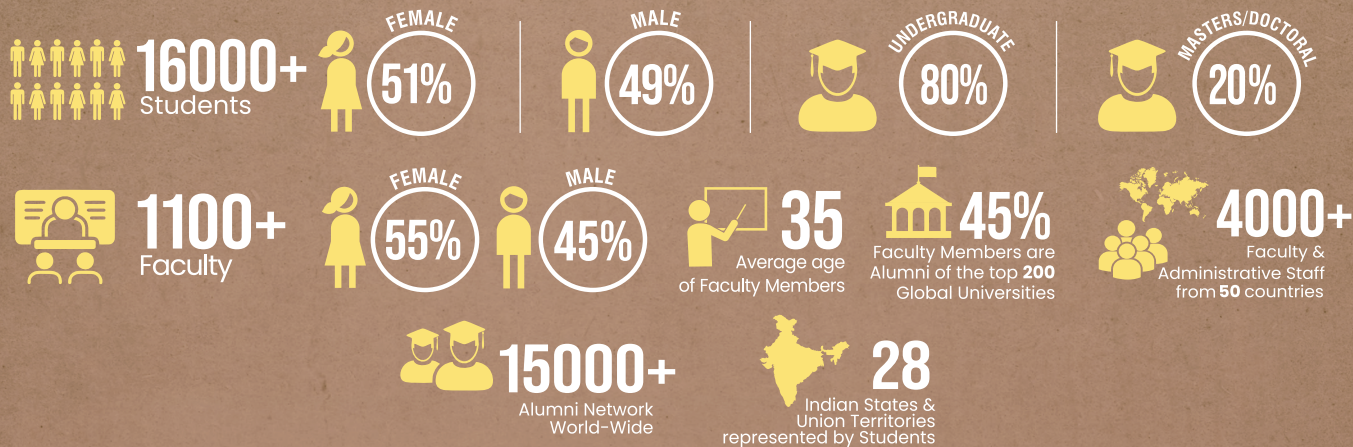
