Born 1966 in Jerusalem, Inbal completed her MA at the Institute for Contemporary Jewry at The Hebrew University of Jerusalem. She also earned a Teaching Diploma, Group Facilitation Certificate, and graduated from the Raoul Wallenberg Program for the Promotion of Young Leadership at The Hebrew University of Jerusalem. Inbal has held numerous positions in informal education.

Since 2000, she has been the Director of the Study Seminars Department at the International School for Holocaust Studies of Yad Vashem. From 1999-2002 she directed the Training Course for Israeli Youth Delegations to Poland in the ISHS. In her capacity as the director of the Study Seminars Department she oversees more than 150 staff members and is responsible for a wide-range of programming designed for youth and the Israeli armed forces, which includes the guiding of all educational groups on the Yad Vashem campus. Inbal additionally initiates and manages various interdisciplinary projects promoting Holocaust remembrance by using the arts as a medium of memory.

Inbal resides outside of Jerusalem; she is married and the proud mother of two children.
