P.R. Kumaraswamy is a Professor at the School of International Studies, Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU), New Delhi. He was a Research Fellow at the Harry S. Truman Research Institute for the Advancement of Peace, the Hebrew University of Jerusalem (1991-1999). Ever since joining JNU in September 1999, he has been researching, teaching and writing on various aspects of contemporary Middle East. His works include *India's Israel Policy* (Columbia University Press, 2010) and *A to Z of Arab-Israeli Conflict* (Scarecrow, 2009). He is the editor of the Sage journal Contemporary Review of the Middle East.
