**Professor Uri Ram** Professor Ben-Gurion University of the Negev, Israel

Uri Ram is Professor of Sociology at Ben Gurion University of the Negev, Beer Sheva, Israel and Head of the Humphrey Institute for Social Research. Prof. Ram is the author of numerous scholarly publications in the fields of nationalism, collective memory, the sociology of knowledge, political sociology and globalization. His recent books are *The Globalization of Israel: McWorld in Tel Aviv, Jihad in Jerusalem* (Routledge 2007) and *Israeli Nationalism: Social Conflicts and the Politics of Knowledge* (Routledge 2011). His research interests focus on the dialectics of the globalization of Israeli society, and especially the encounter between the "global" and the "local". He analyzes the growing hiatus between two tendencies that struggle over the definition of Israeli identity: ethno-nationalism (neo-Zionism) and civic-liberalism (Post-Zionism).
