Legal studies is the interdisciplinary study of law. This programme seeks to equip students with the capacity for scholarly inquiry into legal history, sociology, philosophy, politics, economy, psychology, and culture to understand the foundational context and ecosystem in which laws and legal institutions work. Anchored in comprehending various areas of law, the programme will provide avenues to students to explore law as an art and a science. It will also foster critical inquiry among students to examine convergence and divergence between law and justice, the rule of law, and fairness. In short, the programme will encourage students to develop their legal imagination in existing and emerging areas of law in local, national, and global contexts.

TEACHING AND LEARNING FROM THE PROGRAMME

Bachelor of arts in legal studies, offered by the Jindal Global Law School (JGLS), O.P. Jindal Global University (JGU), is a 3-year undergraduate degree programme in liberal arts with a major in legal studies. Combining major subjects in legal studies with minor subjects, multidisciplinary subjects, and courses in enhancing abilities, skills and values required in today's times, the aims and objectives of teaching and learning from the programme are as follows:

- » Provide an understanding of the rule of law and principles of justice.
- » Develop comprehension of the roles and responsibilities of lawyers, judges, law and policy makers.
- » Provide insights into Indian and global legal systems and contexts.
- » Build the ability to identify legal issues, evaluate arguments, and solve problems.
- » Foster legal imagination for anticipating and addressing emerging areas of law.
- » Develop critical thinking and research skills for performing pre-legal and paralegal work and research.
- » Enhance rhetorical skills in reading, listening, speaking and writing.

FUTURE PROSPECTS AFTER THE PROGRAMME

The programme aims to prepare students for further studies in law and other disciplines. This degree will not enable its holder to enrol as an advocate to practice law, but will provide pathways to pursue studies and careers in law, legal research, legal education, pre-legal, paralegal and allied legal services. It will also provide grounding for students to diversify into policy analysis, public service, diplomatic service, legal journalism, corporate social responsibility, joining compliance mechanisms, legal communication, legal and ethical practices in publication and other media content creation and international travel-related laws and regulations.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Applicants to the B.A. Legal Studies at JGLS must have successfully passed the examination at the 10+2 level of schooling from a recognised board. This course is open to students from any stream including Arts, Commerce, Science, etc.

3+3 PATHWAY

A student can pursue 3 year LL.B. degree after completing the B.A. degree in Legal Studies.

3 YEARS COURSE DURATION **10+2** MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY

SELECTION PROCESS

Admission to the 3-year B.A. Legal Studies programme of Jindal Global Law School will be on the basis of National Level Entrance Exams including **LNAT-UK/JSAT-Law/CLAT-UG/CUET-UG**.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Merit-cum-means scholarship shall be awarded to students qualifying **LNAT-UK/JSAT-Law/CLAT-UG/CUET-UG**, subject to parental ITR criteria as defined by university.

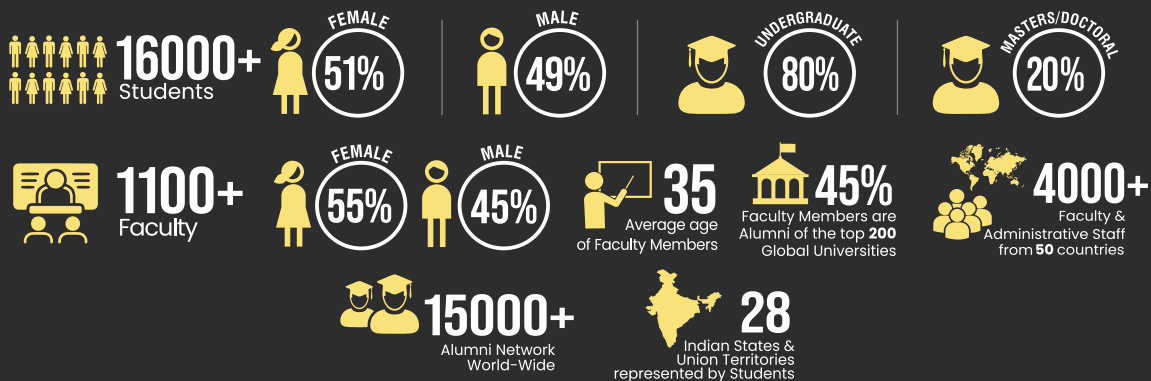
