Regulating Digital Journalism: Processes and Principles

Among the many changes that the new IT Rules 2021 heralds a wholesale regulation of digital journalism in India. Native digital outlets such as The Wire or The Quint are expected to set up grievance redressal mechanisms to address complaints from aggrieved users, organise industry bodies, and submit to the decisions of an Executive body composed of members from various ministries. These Rules represent the first substantial set of regulations on journalism online. How are we to assess the new IT Rules and their potential impact on online journalism, digital journalists, and - more broadly - free expression and democracy in India? And how are we to situate these regulations with older and extant regulations that already apply to print and broadcast media? To help us decode these question, Prof. Sukumar Muralidharan will join us in CRAFT & Law's first edition of a new conversation series entitled "NETWORK DIALOGUES". The Network Dialogues aims to foster conversations in JGU around new issues of law, policy, and practice, arising in the information society.
