Litigation Activism & the Changing Dynamics of Legal Advocacy

In the past decade, the legal-technology landscape in India has witnessed everything from net neutrality & privacy regulations to health privacy & pandemic laws, increasing cultural regulation, and legalisation of a censorship regime. Given these developments, conversations on the blurred lines between online and offline freedoms, and rights have become more pronounced today. A crucial player in helping us understand the impact of the legal-technology landscape has been the civil society, and particularly young digital activists, both inside and outside courts.
