About Keynote Speaker

Mr. Ramanan Ramanathan is a Senior Vice President with Tata Consultancy Services. He also served as the first Mission Director of the Atal Innovation Mission. As the first Mission Director of the Atal Innovation Mission, he was instrumental in shaping the innovation policy of the Government of India and in establishing over 7000 Atal Tinkering Labs in schools across the country. This provided access to emerging technologies for more than 3.5 million students. He was also responsible for setting up incubators throughout India incubating more than 2000 start-ups, more than 30% of which are led by women entrepreneurs. Atal Innovation Mission also developed one of the largest mentorship networks under his leadership with over 10000 people registering to mentor young school students and start-ups.
