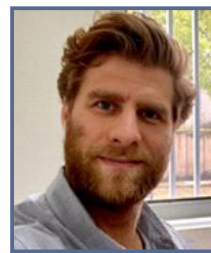

SPEAKER BIOS

Mr. Michael C. Tredway, a US citizen, was born in Tripoli, Libya and has spent most of his adult life, over 30 years, working in Africa on US government and USAID projects including Humanitarian Assistance, Infrastructure Development, National Emergency Management Operations, Peace and Stability Operations, Counter-Poaching Operations, and Leadership Development. Mr. Tredway has also worked for and with International Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) facilitating Humanitarian Assistance and Outreach Programs. He has lived and worked in more than 20 of the 54 African countries and visited several others. Mr. Tredway has a Master of Arts degree in Emergency and Disaster Management. He has written two internationally published books – Smiles Across East Africa and Tales from Around the African Campfire”.

Mr. Benjamin Moore is of Danish and British descent. He started working in the UN in 2015 in China and moved to South Sudan in 2017, where he now works in UN Coordination as Special Assistant to the DSRSG/RC/HC. He has delved into the various strategic and technical aspects of peacebuilding and sustaining peace. He works with the Peacebuilding Fund that includes identification of strategic peacebuilding interventions, formulation of specific projects to support important mechanisms that prevent conflict and sustain peace, monitoring project implementation, and progress, and finally liaison with Peacebuilding Support Office (PBSO) on financing opportunities. He also supports project implementation, progress reporting, and activity adjustments among the many other coordination functions.
