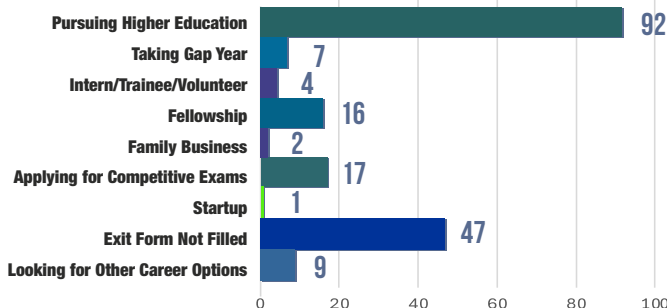

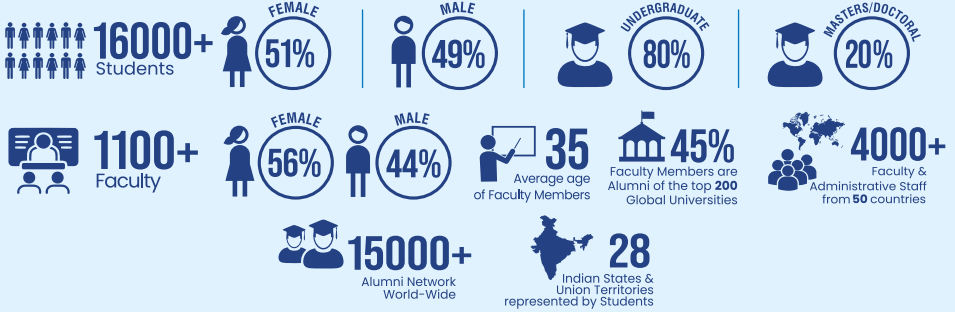
SCHOLARSHIPS
