


University hall of residence for students consists of several blocks of buildings designed by a French Architect.

Minimum Eligibility for Post Graduate Degree Programme at JSPC

Successful completion of a Psychology major or Bachelor's degree in Psychology, Social Work, Sociology, or related fieldsfrom a recognized University in India or abroad.

Please note: Students with an International Bachelor's degree must submit an equivalency certificate from the Association of Indian Universities (AIU).

Accepted Standardized Test
