Vandana Chaudhry is an Associate Professor in the Department of Social Work at the City University of New York – College of Staten Island. Dr. Chaudhry's research focuses on disability in the Global South, digitalization, neoliberal governance, disability justice, and culturally competent practices. Dr. Chaudhry's scholarship appears in journals such as 'Disability and Society,' 'International Social Work,' and 'Qualitative Inquiry.' Her article "Living at the Edge: Disability, Gender, and Neoliberal Debtscales of Microfinance in India" received the 2016 Affilia Award for Distinguished Feminist Scholarship and Praxis in Social Work. For her work, Dr. Chaudhry has received grants from the Center for Democracy and Technology, Ford Foundation, National Science Foundation, and CUNY, among others. As a public scholar, Dr. Chaudhry provides expert opinion and consultation to disability policy and advocacy organizations such as the UN-Enable, disability state agencies, and disabled peoples' organizations locally and globally.
