Dr. Priya Nanda is a global health research and evaluation specialist whose expertise spans gender, intersectionality, and rights-based approaches to transforming complex health systems, with a strong focus on addressing structural inequalities. As a consultant, she works with organizations such as BRAC, the World Bank, and Global Health 50/50, bringing focused attention to advancing gender integration across their programs and strategies. Previously, she served as Senior Program Officer with the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation in India and as Portfolio Director at the International Center for Research on Women's (ICRW) Asia Regional Office in New Delhi. She was also Co-Director of the Gender and Adolescence: Global Evidence (GAGE) consortium, led by ODI. Priya holds a Ph.D. in Health Economics from Johns Hopkins University, a Master of International Affairs from Columbia University, and both a Master's and Bachelor's in Economics from the University of Delhi. She is an Adjunct Faculty member at the University of North Carolina's Department of Maternal and Child Health, a member of the Scientific and Technical Advisory Group of the WHO's Human Reproduction Program and served as the alumni lead for Women Lift Health India.
