

BIO OF SPEAKERS

Architect Ashok Lall

Ashok Lall, b. 1948, graduated from the University of Cambridge, U.K., in Architecture & Fine Arts and obtained the Architectural Association Diploma in 1970. His architectural firm (estd. 1981) is committed to an architectural practice based on the principles of environmental sustainability and social responsibility. The firm has won a number of awards, and its work has been published widely. Engaged in architectural education since 1990, he has developed curricula and teaching methods to address environmental issues. He has been invited to present his work on sustainable design in India and internationally, including the UK, Australia, Switzerland, Egypt, Indonesia, Sri Lanka, Nepal, Uganda, Iran, the Philippines and Mexico. He was chair of the Jury for the Holcim Awards for Sustainable Construction, Asia Pacific Region. He was the Design & Technology Chair at Kamla Raheja Vidyanidhi Institute for Architecture (KRVIA), Mumbai.

With a career spanning over four decades, Madhu Pandit has made a lasting impact in the fields of Architecture and Education. An alumna of the School of Planning & Architecture, she is a Partner at BARGAD Design, an initiative of NMA, an award-winning Architectural practice in New Delhi. From contributing to landmark projects like the National Gallery of Modern Art Extension in New Delhi, to empowering women through building training programmes in Rajasthan as a founder member of GRAAM (Group for Relevant Architecture and Appropriate Methods), Madhu has consistently championed the values of sustainability and inclusivity. At BARGAD, she continues to lead transformative projects globally. She also values teaching and has been an Adjunct Professor at IIAD since 2020.
