Understanding the Psychosocial Effects of Gaming and Al in Children and Adolescents



Prof. (Dr.) Manish Kumar Asthana, Associate Professor at the Department of Humanities & Social Sciences, Indian Institute of Technology Roorkee, earned his doctoral degree in 2013 from the University of Wuerzburg, Germany. He completed post-doctoral fellowships in social cognitive neuroscience at Mackenzie Presbyterian University (Brazil) and IIT Kanpur (India). His research focuses on pathological learning and memory mechanisms, with significant biological implications, particularly in the area of associative fear learning and its modulation. In his talk on "Understanding the Psychosocial Effects of Gaming and AI in Children and Adolescents", Dr. Asthana will discuss how gaming and AI, while offering fun and fulfilling basic social needs, also raise concerns due to negative psychosocial effects such as frustration, irritability, and social withdrawal. He will explore how rapid technological advances and AI have reshaped gaming practices and influenced the psychological development of young minds.



Application of AI in Mental Health Practice: Boon or Bane?



Prof. (Dr.) Naveen Grover, Head of the Centre for Psychotherapy Integration and Supervision (CPIR) at IHBAS, Delhi, is a Professor of Clinical Psychology with over two decades of experience in teaching, training, and research in mental health. A registered clinical psychologist in India, New Zealand, and the UK, he has contributed extensively through publications, workshops, and lectures at national and international forums. His core interests include learning under supervision and enhancing accessibility of mental health care. In his talk on "Application of Al in Mental Health Practice: Boon or Bane?", Prof. Grover will explore how AI can improve access, early detection, and personalised care through chatbots, screening tools, and data-driven insights, while addressing concerns around privacy, ethics, and the potential loss of human empathy emphasising the need to balance technology with the human touch
