Short bio of Speaker:

Dr. Parul Bansal, Professor of Psychology at Lady Shri Ram College, University of Delhi, is a distinguished scholar in social, cultural, and critical psychology and psychoanalysis. Her work has been widely published in Scopus and SSCIindexed journals such as Culture and Psychology, Psychological Studies, Human Arenas, and Integrative Psychological and Behavioural Science, addressing contemporary issues including nationalism, acculturation, indigenous knowledge systems, the psychosocial impact of COVID-19, and critical developmental psychology. She is the author of three major books, most recently Re-envisioning Psychology: Debating Paradigmatic Foundations (Routledge, 2024), and has contributed chapters to edited volumes from Springer and Emerald, as well as academic content for IGNOU. Prof. Bansal has presented her research at esteemed forums including the American University of Paris and the International Association for Cross-Cultural Psychology and has been a speaker and panelist at events by the APA, NAOP, and PRIA. She has delivered keynote addresses at conferences organized by the British Psychological Society (UK) and the International Society of Critical Health Psychology (Ireland). Additionally, she has led workshops on qualitative research, identity development, and psychoanalytic theory, and was a TEDx speaker at LSR in 2014 with her talk titled "Are We Free? Images of Individuality." Prof. Bansal continues to be a key figure in advancing critical psychological thought and education in India.
