Mental health is a critical component of overall well-being, yet access to mental healthcare and the prevalence of mental health issues are unevenly distributed across populations, societies and ethnic races. In India, marginalized groups - including but not limited to Dalits, Adivasis (Scheduled Tribes), LGBTQIA+ individuals, persons with disabilities, and economically weaker sections, often experience disproportionately higher rates of mental health challenges. These challenges are frequently rooted in systemic discrimination, social exclusion, poverty, violence, lack of access to resources (including healthcare), and historical trauma. Despite the growing recognition of mental health's importance, the specific issues faced by these communities often remain under-addressed in policy, research, and public discourse. While this event primarily focuses on the theme of Mental Health of Marginalized Groups, we have adopted an interdisciplinary approach to gain comprehensive a more understanding of marginalization. Aligned with the sustainable goals provided by the United Nations (2023), such as Goal 1 (No poverty), Goal 3 (Good health and wellbeing), Goal 10 (Reduced inequalities), Goal 11 (Sustainable cities and communities), and Goal (Partnerships for goals), this conference aims to create a platform for dialogue, knowledge sharing, and collaboration among researchers, practitioners, policymakers, to understand these complex issues and work towards equitable solutions.
