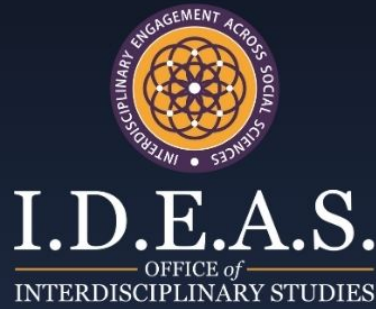
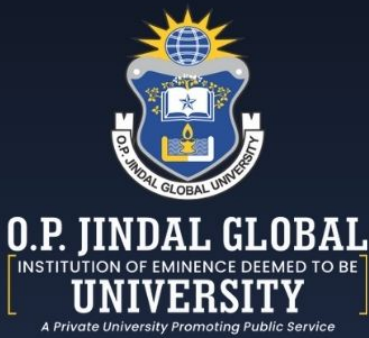

Development, as a concept, has often been understood as a process that offers contradictory outcomes for countries in the Global South. As a rapidly developing nation, India faces multifaceted challenges requiring innovative and interdisciplinary solutions. For example, even as the last decade has seen a steady increase in GDP and educational attainment in India, youth unemployment has also increased, a phenomenon that some call jobless growth. As countries in the Global South strive for GDP growth and development, their people, particularly those from poor and marginalised communities, are becoming even more vulnerable to the climate crisis that results from unbridled growth. The MSc in Development Studies at IDEAS aims to equip students with theoretical knowledge, fieldwork experiences, and practical skills to examine and address these difficult challenges.

By focusing on a combination of theory, skills, experimental and real-world experiences, the programme prepares students to bridge the gap between societal need, policy design, and implementation while centring inclusion and people's well-being. Alongside addressing development challenges, ensuring our students' employability has been a principal factor in conceptualising the programme.

Catering to both working professionals and fresh graduates, the Development Studies programme is designed to include several skills and research-based courses that prepare students for successful careers in the development sector and beyond. Classes will be held in an online mode, enabling students to pursue the programme from any location, while managing their jobs or other commitments.

**MR. AMARJEET SINHA**

**Former IAS and Senior Fellow,  
Centre for Social and Economic Progress**

Amarjeet Sinha is a Senior Fellow at the Centre for Social and Economic Progress, with over four decades of experience in public policy and governance. An IAS officer of the 1983 Bihar cadre, he retired in 2019 as Secretary, Department of Rural Development, Government of India, and later served as Advisor to the Prime Minister (till July 2021) and Member, Public Enterprises Selection Board (2022–24).

He played a pivotal role in designing landmark initiatives such as the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan, National Rural Health Mission, and governance reforms across livelihoods, housing, skills, employment, and social security. He also led the Gram Swaraj Abhiyan (2018), delivering seven key welfare interventions to over 63,000 villages.

A Rhodes Scholar and St. Stephen's College alumnus, Sinha has published eight books and numerous articles on public policy, poverty reduction, and human development. He has taught at leading institutions including the Indian School of Business, IRMA, and the Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration.

He currently chairs the Gender Expert Committee of the RBI Innovation Hub, serves on boards of IIHMR, HelpAge India, and CSDS, and is involved in initiatives on education, health, nutrition, climate action, and livelihoods. He has also been a jury member for The Indian Express Governance Awards.
