

Dr. Raman Kapur is one of India's foremost Acupuncture specialists and a recipient of the prestigious Padma Shri Award (2008), the first in the field of acupuncture in the country. He completed his MBBS from the University College of Medical Sciences, New Delhi, and has since devoted over four decades to clinical practice, research, and teaching in acupuncture. He is the Chairperson of the Department of Acupuncture at Sir Ganga Ram Hospital, New Delhi, where he has been leading clinical services and training programs for medical doctors for more than 20 years. He has authored several acclaimed books on acupuncture, presented award-winning research at international platforms, and published in leading journals.

A tireless advocate for integrating acupuncture into mainstream healthcare, Dr. Kapur has been instrumental in framing national guidelines, influencing policy reforms, and securing the Government of India's recognition of acupuncture as an independent system of healthcare in 2019. He currently serves as the Vice Chairman of the Apex Committee on Acupuncture, Government of India, and continues to guide education, research, and regulation in the field.
